Reuse of lodging wood ~Turning Waste into Treasure

【內文 Content】

林地常有因颱風豪雨造成樹木傾倒，為保護遊客安全，危及遊客安全之倒伏木皆予以移除，部分留用於現場旁，提供生物利用，本區常見山豬於此啃食腐木中蟻類。

移除之倒伏木，園區將木材收集回收整理後，暫時放置於儲木架，未來可提供於邊坡沖蝕崩落時木製擋土柵工等水土保持工法使用。

Forest lands often experience fallen trees due to typhoons and heavy rain. To protect visitor safety, all fallen wood that poses a risk is removed. Some of this wood is left on-site to provide biological benefits; for instance, wild boars are commonly seen in this area foraging for ants within the decaying wood.

For the removed fallen wood, the park collects, recycles, and organizes the timber, temporarily placing it in storage racks. In the future, this wood can be utilized for soil and water conservation techniques, such as constructing wooden soil retention fences during slope erosion or landslides.
