Basic Information: An endemic subspecies of Taiwan, with a total length of approximately 25 cm.

Physical Characteristics: The entire body is a brilliant bluish-black, exhibiting a blue metallic luster when shimmering in the sunlight.

Distribution: A common resident bird found in forests at altitudes ranging from 400 to 2,300 meters.

Ecological Habits: They usually active in the upper forest canopy, either solitary or in small groups. They primarily prey on flying insects. They frequently join mixed-species flocks with the Gray-chinned Minivet, creating a striking and prominent contrast of red, yellow, and black colors.

Calls: Their calls are loud and highly varied, ranging from mellow, rounded whistles to harsh, raspy notes. They often emit sounds like "ji-ya, ji-ya, jiu-jiu-jiu" or a humorous "Wei! Wei! Operator (Zong-ji)—".
